OFFICIAL FOREIGN RESERVES December 2020

Official foreign reserves held by the National Reserve Bank of Tonga (NRBT) rose significantly over the month of December 2020 by \$85.4 million to \$675.6 million and equivalent to 11.5 months of imports. This was due mainly to receipts of donor funds to support Tonga's recovery from COVID-19 and Cyclone Harold. Similarly, the foreign reserves increased significantly in the year to December 2020 by \$188.2 million attributed to higher receipts of budget support and official grants.
