OFFICIAL FOREIGN RESERVES April 2021

Official foreign reserves held by the National Reserve Bank of Tonga (NRBT) decreased over the month of April 2021 by \$6.0 million to \$679.7 million, equivalent to 11.6 months of imports. This was mainly attributed to large payments for capital payments and oil imports. Nevertheless, foreign reserves still increased significantly over the year by \$204.6 million underpinned by receipts of budget support, official grants, and remittances.
